The favourite topic of conversation among long-distance seafarers is home. Although they spend ninety per cent of their lives on board ship, their minds and hearts are always turning to home and their families.

Maintaining contact with home during voyages was practically impossible in the past. That has become much easier with the advent of mobile phones and social media, but the COVID-19 outbreak has shown how vulnerable that link remains.

The main aim of the Stella Maris (Apostleship of the Sea) chaplains, has always been to facilitate the links with home, and although they were unable to provide a physical welcome or community experience during social isolation, they were still able to provide the one thing the seafarers were desperate for – SIM cards for their mobile phones. At times it was back to old-fashioned style communication with a bucket loaded with SIM cards, welfare packages and chocolate being hoisted on deck...but they made it!
