Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

For St. John, it is Jesus 'mother, Mary, who encourages Jesus to perform his first miraculous sign. The story has touches of comedy. Jesus turns up at a wedding feast in Cana with all his disciples, perhaps causing a few catering anxieties for the organisers.

Jesus' mother spots that they are running out of wine. No wonder! The initial exchange between mother and son is that of a mother dealing with a reluctant teenager. Like all good mothers, Mary ignores her son's response and tells the servants to follow his instructions.

Jesus creates the equivalent of nine hundred bottles of choice wine. The ordinary has become the extraordinary, the water into wine, a sign of what is to come. Mary is there at the heart of this transformation, just as she will be at the foot of the cross with the beloved disciple. She is now joined with her son in the fullness of his glory.

Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary



Patron Saint of France and Lebanon

The Assumption of Mary into heaven is a logical consequence of the dogma the Immaculate Conception. Because Mary was born without original sin, she did not suffer its consequences, among which is death. Because she was a kind of Ark of the New Covenant, carrying the Church in the person of Christ, God preserved her from sin and wanted her in His presence when her time on earth ceased. No saint has ever enjoyed such a privilege because no saint ever had the relationship with Christ that Mary enjoyed.

Sometimes it's hard to appreciate the beauty and majesty of a massive landscape without a person to give it scale. How high is that waterfall? How tall is that mountain peak? How far is that shore? Place a person in the field of vision and suddenly the image makes more sense. fills every scene with his majesty. He is almost too much to take in. But Mary God scale gives and perspective. She humanizes the view. Mary is always there in the foreground, showing the faithful how to approach God and render Him due honour.
